 <p>In Patient Hospital care</p>	<p>As a patient of our public clinics (Specific Domino and Homebirth Service care info next column):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your care during labour and birth will be provided by the Labour and Birthing Unit midwives. If medical assistance is required, it will be provided by the obstetric team of the day with guidance and consultation from the on call Consultant Obstetrician. If you choose to avail of epidural pain relief, this will be administered by a registrar from the anaesthetic team of the day. If you need to be admitted to the hospital before your baby is born, inpatient hospital care is provided by our hospital midwives. Obstetric decisions about your care are made by the obstetric team of the day with guidance and consultation from the on call Consultant Obstetrician. The same applies to your postnatal stay. Your baby's day two physical examination is carried out by the hospital paediatric team on duty or by a Midwife who has trained in this area. 	<p>As a public patient of The Domino and Homebirth Service:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you are having a Domino Birth, care during your labour and birth will be provided by a member of The Domino Midwifery Team. If medical assistance is required, it will be provided by the obstetric team of the day with guidance and consultation from the on call Consultant Obstetrician. Your baby's day two physical examination will be either carried out by the hospital paediatric team on duty or in your home by an experienced Midwife who is trained in this area. 	<p>As a patient of our semi private clinic:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your care during labour and birth will be provided by the Labour and Birthing Unit midwives. If medical assistance is required, it will be provided by the obstetric team of the day with guidance and consultation from the on call Consultant Obstetrician. If you choose to avail of epidural pain relief, this will usually be administered by a Consultant Anaesthetist. If you need to be admitted to the hospital before your baby is born, inpatient hospital care is provided by our hospital midwives. Obstetric decisions about your care are made by the obstetric team of the day with guidance and consultation from the on call Consultant Obstetrician. The same applies to your postnatal stay. Your baby's day two physical examination is carried out by the Consultant Paediatrician on duty. 	<p>As a Private Patient:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your care during labour and birth will be provided by the Labour and Birthing Unit midwives. If medical assistance is required, it will be provided by the obstetric team of the day with decisions made by your chosen Consultant. Your chosen Consultant will be present for your baby's birth and will be available if there are any concerns or complications during the labour or birth (unless on leave when another Consultant will cover). If you choose to avail of epidural pain relief, this will usually be administered by a Consultant Anaesthetist. If you need to be admitted to the hospital before your baby is born, inpatient hospital care is provided by our hospital midwives. Discussion about your care will take place between the obstetric team of the day and your chosen Consultant. Decisions about your care will be made by your chosen Consultant While staying in hospital after your birth you will be reviewed by your chosen Consultant. Your baby's Day two Physical examination is carried out by the Consultant Paediatrician on duty. Your 6-week check following birth will take place with your chosen Consultant in their private rooms. Your baby's check will take place with your GP unless otherwise arranged.
